



Consignor General Information

- Horses may start to arrive at the sale yard on Thurs. May 3, 2012 after 1:00 pm.
- The office will be open Thursday evening but will be shut down during the preview. On arrival, you can come to the office for assistance in penning your horses. Once settled, we ask that you bring your papers, signed transfers, foal applications (if applicable), and brand manifests to the office. At this time we will also be numbering your horses with their catalog numbers.
- Hay and straw is provided at the sale yard. Most pens have automatic waterers, but a few do not so please bring extra pails.
- Pens will be assigned as consignors arrive. There is ample pen space available but the pens are quite large so we ask that consignors put more than one animal per pen. It is advantageous to have possible pen mates familiar before bringing them to the sale.
- There is a wash rack with warm & cold water available to the consignors.
- The preview is held right at the sale yard in a large outdoor pen. There is also a 60 foot round pen available to work loose cattle. The preview will show riding horses, round pen work, barrel horses and then rope horses, There is a good opportunity to show your horses. Be prepared. We will run riding horses in catalog order as much as possible. Horses worked on cattle and roped on will be shown as presented. If you feel you are not getting equal opportunity please assert yourself or talk to sale management.
- We ask that you represent your horse as honestly as possible. This decreases problems after the sale.
- The sale yard cafeteria will be open, as well there will be additional food vendors on sale day.
- There will be a small trade show open Fri, and Sat.
- The sale will be held in catalog order.
- Auctioneers and ringmen are available to you for questions as well.
- ***No horses will be cataloged if appropriate catalog fees do not accompany consignment forms.***
- We accept mc/visa/cash....cheques by bank authorization. Please be aware of daily limits, and if you are going to pay by debit. Please extend your limits before the sale.
- Sold or passed registration papers will not be given out sale day. They will be sent to the owners after the sale.
- ***We are there to make your day as successful as possible. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak to sale management and we will do our best to accommodate you. We all can work together to make the sale as successful as possible. If you are a new consignor; Welcome. If you are a previous consignor, we are glad to have you back. See you at the sale.***

Terms & Conditions

- Open to all consignments, including geldings, mares, young stock and studs.
***Please Note: Our yearling consignments are limited - please notify sale management about yearling consignments.
- Horses will be entered in the catalog on the order paid entries are received; therefore enter early for a good sale position.
- Consignors guarantee that each horse is:
 - a) sound of eyes, wind and limb
 - b) not a cribber
 - c) has not been nerved or has navicular disease
 - d) is not a cryptorchid or a ridgeling
 - e) is not a parrot mouth
 - f) no pending papers allowed, owners must have original copy of permanent registry
- Consignors understand that buyers will have until noon on Monday to notify sale management if a horse has been misrepresented.
- Cattle will be available at preview to be roped or shown on \$25.00 stock charge on each horse
- \$20.00 yardage will be charged on all horses (includes feed, bedding, brand inspection).
- Late entries will be accepted until sale day and will be added to the catalog supplement sheet (same selling charges apply)
- For any horses entered in the catalog that do not show at the sale, the consignor must produce a vet certificate from a reputable horse veterinarian. Any consignor failing to do so will be subject to a \$250.00 no show charge. This charge will be strictly enforced to protect credibility of the consignors and sales management.
- Western Horse Sales Unlimited and its associates act as agents only and are not responsible for buyer-seller error or misunderstanding. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller. Horses will be sold as registered only if papers and transfers are furnished to Western Horse Sales Unlimited before the sale. The consignor has the privilege to “no sale” or “pass out” their horse. If the horse is passed out, the cost will be the catalog fee plus \$100.00 pass out fee. Catalog fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
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Soundness Guarantee

- All horses ridden through the ring and sell as a result of being ridden through the ring are “guaranteed sound” until Monday noon following the Saturday sale. Western Horse Sales Unlimited considers sound as:
 - a) Sight in both eyes
 - b) Good in the air
 - c) Hit the ground sound on all four feet
 - d) Not to crib
- Western Horse Sales Unlimited expects all consignors to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner that is accommodating to the buyers. All consigned horses shall be fit to the best of the consignor’s ability, to include healthy horses that exhibit higher body scores, with a good hair coat. Horses should be bathed and clean for presentation come sale day. Our facilities have an indoor warm water wash rack just for our consignors. Horses should also be freshly shod or trimmed and should exhibit the appearance that they have been well cared for.
